

PERSI Choice 401(k) Plan Investment Options

When you enroll in the Choice 401(k) Plan, you decide how to invest your account contributions. Until you make this decision, your contributions will automatically be invested in the PERSI Total Return Fund.

When you decide to create your own portfolio, you review and select the investment funds you're interested in, and manage your account on an ongoing basis. You can select from the different investment funds shown below, including the Total Return Fund, to create a diversified portfolio.

You should also consider how investment management fees might affect your overall returns. For example, let's assume you have \$30,000 in retirement savings within the Choice 401(k) Plan. Compare how much you might pay in fees during the year if you choose to invest in a fund with an investment management fee of .90% versus a fund with an investment management fee of .30%:
