At 2:03 p. m, Chairman Cilek called the meeting to order.

Choice 401(k)Plan Annual Review

Diane Kaiser presented an overview of today's agenda and introduced the new assistant manager for the Choice plan – Dan Gardner.

Ann O'Bradovich and Ben Taylor presented a summary of the Plan's investment options an overview of the plan structure and design for the Choice 401 (k) Plan as well as the performance of the 2Q 2024. In addition, Callan provided an overview of 2023 DC trends survey, including SECURE 2.0 optional provisions and the appropriateness of the default investment option.

Callan and staff provided recommended changes to the Choice 401(k) Plan policy statement for the Board's consideration.

Trustee Fisher moved to adopt the recommended changes to the Choice 401 (k) plan policy statement including non-substantive technical corrections recommended by Trustee DeAngeli. Trustee DeAngeli seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Diane Kaiser provided a review of the impact of Secure 2.0 Act, focusing on the provisions allowing long-term part-time employee's the option to participate in 401(k) plans and the addition of Roth contributions.

Stephanie O'Dear and Dave Ramirez presented Empower's vision, mission and technological investments as well as an overview of the Choice 401(k) plan's metrics, contribution activity, loan activity, asset allocation, and joint successes achieved.

Mike Anderson provided an annual review of administrative and investment fees for the Choice 401(k) Plan.
